From the Principal's Desk

The Bible consistently speaks of honesty and integrity, which illustrates the importance of these virtues. As adults, we have seen the importance of being honest and truthful in many aspects of our lives. We also know the pitfalls and temptations that can challenge even our own practice of the value of honesty and its companion virtue, integrity.

Honesty is being truthful and sincere, which builds trusting relationships. When people are honest, they can be trusted not to lie, cheat, or steal. Integrity is adhering to moral principle, being faithful to moral conscience, keeping your word, and standing up for what we believe. Simply stated, integrity is being truthful to yourself, and honesty is telling the truth to others.

How can you help your child develop and appreciation for the practice of honesty and integrity in every aspect of is or her life?

- Work together to identify your family's values regarding honesty and integrity.
- Model honesty for your child. For example, if a clerk in a store gives you too much change, correct the situation immediately. Admit if you have fudged the truth and apologize.
- ♦ Don't overreact when your child lies to you. Children will lie if they fear your reaction. Instead give your child every opportunity to tell the truth. Ask, "Are you being honest?" and remind your child that they can always tell you the truth.
- Take every opportunity to demonstrate and show that you appreciate truth-telling in every situation. Spend time with your child reinforcing the importance of honesty.
- Be consistent in modeling your integrity for your child to observe. Be true to your word.
- Help your child develop an ability to be kind and tell the truth from a loving place.

Cultivating honesty and integrity in your child is one of the greatest and most enduring gifts you can provide. These values will not only benefit your children, but also the world around them.
