TRANSITION TO THE WINTER UNIFORM

Friday, September 30th will be the last day for khaki shorts and skorts as well as the green dresses to be worn as they are considered "warm weather" uniform. Green shirts will be allowed with plaid skirts/skorts, jumpers or khaki pants for the girls. All girls must also wear navy, white or black knee high socks with skirts/skorts and jumpers. Socks with prints are not permitted. Boys can wear navy or khaki pants with white, navy, or black ankle socks. Formal uniforms (no green shirts) will still be mandatory on days we celebrate mass. The acceptable layers, in the case that a child gets cold in the classroom, are the navy blue uniform cardigans and pullover sweaters or the fleeces with the logo. Middle school students may wear hoodies from our school athletic teams except during Mass. No other hoodies, flannels, sweatshirts, or sweaters will be permitted in the classrooms.
