We encourage outside/active play in the afternoons and there should be no homework assigned unless it is make-up work.


Please be sure your child(ren) are at school by 8:15am as testing starts promptly in the mornings and encourage your students to simply try their best.

2023-2024 Registration & Tuition Contracts

Returning families should have received their tuition contracts for the 2023-2024 academic year last week. Registration deposits (\$150 for those paying monthly and \$85 for those making one or two payments) along with contracts will be due back by Friday, May 12th. These deposits (one per family) are non-refundable and they are not to be deducted from the total tuition. Contracts must be signed in order to re-enroll your children for the next school year. Please also remember to note if you'd like to include your book fees in your tuition payments.
