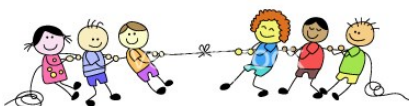


Fun day will take place on Monday, June 10th. This happens rain or shine and is a FULL day.

- Fourth Grade: \$150
- Fifth Grade: \$150
- Sixth Grade: \$160
- Seventh Grade: \$160
- Eighth Grade: \$160
