This Lenten Season

Each year, the church sets aside 40 days as a special time we call LENT. This year's Lenten season began on Ash Wednesday, February 14th. We held a beautiful Ash Service here at school because the weather prevented us from attending Mass on that day.

As a school, we will be doing the Stations of the Cross on Fridays during Lent either following Mass at church or in the afternoons at school. There will be a Family Stations of the Cross on Friday, March 15th at 5:30pm at Sacred Heart St. Francis de Sales church.

Each child has received a packet of Lenten goodies to share with their families. Fr. Kevin spoke to us all on Ash Wednesday about praying, fasting, and almsgiving during this Lenten season. It is important for us to journey together and remember all the sacrifices Jesus made for all of us. The 'rice bowls' will be collected during Holy Week. You can return them to the parish or school office.

Tuition Assistance for the 2024-2025 School Year

Tuition assistance applications must be done online again through FACTS. Families who are currently enrolled and seeking tuition assistance must have this application done by March 31st, 2024. If you are seeking assistance, please keep in mind:

- You must file these forms by the stated due date and include all necessary documentation.
- Amounts will be announced in the beginning of May with the amount of assistance our school is able to offer.
- FACTS has a toll free number if you need help filling out your application.
